Multicut

- A universal blade that should be used on a varied range of materials

Duocut

 - Has a specially developed segment that will cut concrete, tarmac and asphalt and is very useful in a combination of asphalt over concrete

Safety Instructions

- DO** - Mount the blade on the correct diameter arbor shaft
- DO** - Inspect the blade daily for excessive wear or damage to segment, centre or bore
- DO** - Refer to the machine owners manual before using saw
- DO NOT** - Force the blade into the material being cut. Allow the blade to cut at its own speed. Forcing the blade may lead to excessive overheating and possible damage
- DO NOT** - Grind with the side of the blade as this may result in core damage
- DO NOT** - Make long continuous cuts when using a dry blade. Allow the blade to run in air at regular intervals to aid cooling
